

News from within the Pacific Southwest Region (PSR)... **Regional** updates first. Directors elected earlier this year were installed during a special session Zoom conference call September 15 th . Newly election Directors Chris Thompson (Arizona) and Tim Foote (San Diego), along with incumbents Harold Helland (Cajon) and myself (Los Angeles), were installed by PSR President Pat Raymer.

In other PSR news, President Raymer has announced the appointment of two new Board members: John McGreevy (Nominations and Elections) and Rudy Spano (Membership Services) – replacing Vic Cavalli and Pete Steinmetz respectively. Still vacant is the Non-Rails Chair. Should you be interested in volunteering for this position, contact President Raymer at President@psrnmra.org.

Of course, the biggest Regional activity is associated with preparing to host next year's NMRA National Convention, SurfLiner 2024, August 4 th – 11 th in Long Beach, CA. Much planning has already been completed – did you notice the presentation of Gary (MMR) and Sandy Butts' Gary and Sandy Railroad in the November Issue of the NMRA Magazine? – but, of course, there is always more work to perform. If interested in helping out, contact President Raymer at President@psrnmra.org. One can never have too many volunteers. Now, onto non-Los Angeles "division" news... Although Arizona Division has just hosted this year's PSR annual regional convention, they aren't slowing down any. Now divided "internally" into four (4) more localized "subdivision" – Sonora (Casa Grande River and south), High Country (New River and north), East Valley (east of Phoenix Central Avenue), and West Valley (west of Phoenix Central Avenue) – each area is holding an additional 2-to-3 "closer-by" events annually for their members.

And don't forget they hold a monthly Division (actually, available to all PSR members) interactive Zoom meet the third Saturday of each month. The next two will be held November 18 th and December 16 th . Check Arizona's website, www.azdiv-nmra.org, for current events and details.

Likewise, the Cajon Division has been busy too; having just held two (2) day-long mini-meets: one in Nevada, "Las Vegas Hobos and Trains", the other in Buena Park, their annual "Cajon Fall" meet.




