

Director's Report

Last report I shared discussions, decisions and highlights from our Pacific Southwest Region's (PSR) annual Board of Directors and General Membership meetings. Now, I would like to "close the books" on the region's hosting of SurfLiner 2024, the National Model Railroad Association's (NMRA) annual convention. [Please note, statistics and numbers provided below are from Final Financial Report, SurfLiner 2024, delivered to NMRA National, by Joel Morse, Treasurer and Co-Chairman of SurfLiner 2024.]

Final registration for the convention totaled out at 604 individuals, broken down as follows: 605 full registrations, 63 1- or 2-day attendees, and 64 cancelations. There were six (6) General Interest, four (4) Prototype, and five (5) Layout tours offered – each included transportation provided – with 83, 154 and 198 individuals participating. Eighty-eight (88) members attended one or more of the eight (8) Modeling with the Masters clinics, and a total of 150 registrants attended the final night's Awards Banquet.

While almost everything associated with the convention itself was VERY successful, merchandise sales through the Company Store lost approximately \$5,500.00, and the minimum number of required convention rooms to-be-booked was not met. (Read further on for this latter point.) Financially, the convention brought in a Gross Profit (i.e. incomes from all sources) of \$175,707.67. Gross Expenses (i.e., debits) are currently \$157,343.32 with a few reimbursements still outstanding as of the time this report was submitted. This resulted in a "Final" net surplus of \$18,097.21. Payment of \$14,477.77 (80%) has been forwarded to NMRA National Headquarters; the remaining \$3,619.44 (20%) retained by the PSR.

Thank goodness the staff and volunteers of SurfLiner 2024 weren't motivated by only the money to be made?! Instead, to all involved, **THANK YOU;** an <u>excellent job done!</u>

In closing, I want to share a part of the convention's Co-Chairs' "summary" cover letter to National:

"As we close out the books on the SurfLiner2024 NMRA National Convention, the Host Committee wants the National management team to know that the Convention Chairs, Pat Raymer and Joel Morse, were extremely disappointed with Nationals' refusal to negotiate in good faith to fairly modify the convention agreement in recognition of the potential effect the mismanagement of the National Train Show at the National level (and its downsizing) might, and ultimately did, have on the convention's overall profitability, including attendance and hotel room sales.

"In fact, in May 2024, only 3 months before the convention and following weeks of good faith efforts on the part of the Host Committee to structure a fair agreement that recognized the unique nature of the circumstances impacting SurfLiner2024, National management presented the Host Committee with a "take it or leave it" ultimatum to sign the agreement as no further negotiation would take place. The final agreement does not specifically protect the Host Committee from significant losses as requested; instead it included a parting insult by changing the Net Surplus Distribution from the historic split of 20% National / 80% Host Committee, to 80% National / 20% Host Committee.

"The Host Committee was surprised, disappointed, disillusioned disheartened and insulted, by the National leadership's decision to take this hard line approach and leave us with no choice but to sign the one-sided agreement or cancel the convention at that late date.

"The Host Committee chose to sign the agreement, rather than cancel the SurfLiner2024 and disappoint the NMRA membership planning to attend. And despite the roadblocks created by poor management at the National level, we know that we put on a fine convention." [Editor: Underscore added by the author.]
